**RE: Red Deer River Investigation**

Mountain View County has recently participated in discussion with the Town of Sundre, the Ministry of Environment and the Federal Department of Fisheries on flood and erosion issues on the Red Deer River, West of Sundre. This letter is to keep your organization informed of the ongoing investigation.

The Alberta Ministry of Environment has undertaken an investigation of the river as per the attached Terms of Reference. In addition, the Town of Sundre is also investigating river issues within their own jurisdiction. The results of these investigations will be presented to the respective Councils once they are completed.

The long term concern of the rural area residence is to address the risk presented to road structures and residents during flood events. The goal of those investigations and possible follow up investigations is to present options, if any that would minimize these risks.

Representatives of Mountain View County would be available to meet with or make a presentation to the Association, if requested.
